BYLAW NO. 492-17

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A WASTE MANAGEMENT FEE AND REGULATE THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE & OTHER REFUSE

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to set the fees for waste collection and disposal for residential and commercial properties within the Town of Lafleche.

DEFINITIONS

2. For the purpose of this Bylaw:
 - a) "Collection day" means the day upon which the Town of Lafleche shall provide garbage pick-up to designated properties;
 - b) "Designated property" means a residential and/or commercial building or buildings that generate garbage on site and other properties as the Administrator and Town Foreman shall determine;
 - c) "Garbage" means unwanted household refuse or commercial refuse that is set out for garbage collection and does not include recycling, compost material or demolition material;
 - d) "Occupant" means the person who is in charge of or resides at a property within the Town of Lafleche;
 - e) "Owner" means the registered owner of the property as indicated by Information Services Corporation;
 - f) "Municipal nuisance ground" means the Town and RM of Wood River No. 74 landfill site located at the NW 35-08-05 W3

GENERAL

3. Every resident or commercial property receiving garbage services shall ensure that the garbage meets the following requirements:
 - a) All garbage will be securely bagged, or bundled in a container;
 - b) Council may order the owner or occupant to obtain or provide a proper garbage collection container. If the owner or occupant fails to comply, a container will be supplied at the expense of the owner;
 - c) No garbage bag will weigh more than thirty (30) pounds;
 - d) Any medical garbage, animal garbage, ashes and/or powdered materials must be packaged in securely tied, doubled garbage bags.
4. No person shall set out a container for garbage service at a designated property before the collection day.
5. Where an owner or occupant has garbage to be set out, the owner or occupant shall set it out no later than 8:30 a.m. on the residential collection day; 9:30 a.m. on the commercial collection day.
6. Collection days for garbage service will be as follows:
 - a) *Tuesday's* will be collection day for all commercial businesses/buildings/property and will be collected from the designated area on site as set out in 'Schedule A';

- b) *Wednesday's* will be collection day for all residential properties and will be collected as follows:
- i. April to October of the given year will be in the back alley, at the edge of the designated property, according to the route as set out in 'Schedule B';
 - ii. November to April of the given year, will be at the curb, in front of the designated property, according to the route as set out in 'Schedule C'.
7. No person shall cause or permit a container or uncollected garbage to remain at the set out location after 8:00 p.m. on collection day.
 8. No person shall permit or allow garbage stored or set out for garbage service to create offensive odors or become untidy.
 9. Every owner or occupant receiving garbage service when setting out garbage will do so that it is not obstructing traffic in any way.
 10. Garbage not placed in containers or bags properly, or dealt with as set out in accordance with this bylaw, will not be collected. If the Town of Lafleche is required to remove garbage due to noncompliance with the regulations of this bylaw, all costs associated with its removal will be at the expense of the owner.
 11. Every owner with property not designated for garbage service, and therefore no fees charged, will be responsible for the disposal of garbage to the municipal nuisance ground.

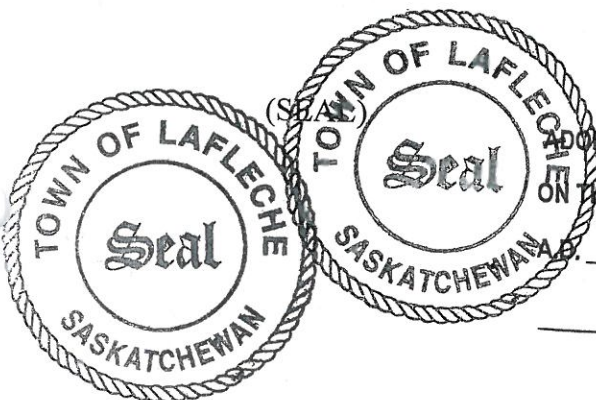
RATES & FEES

12. The Town of Lafleche shall charge rates as set out in 'Schedule D' for waste management (garbage service and collection). The waste management fee shall be charged to the owner or occupant on the same account as the water and sewer service, or utility invoice.
13. Every owner or occupant of a designated property shall pay the waste management fee, even where the owner or occupant does not set out garbage to be collected.
14. Where the owner or occupant fails to make payment on the utility account for waste management, the Town of Lafleche may add the unpaid fees to the tax roll, for the designated property, pursuant to Section 405 of *The Municipalities Act*.

OFFENCES & PENALTIES

15. If any person fails, neglects or refuses to comply with this bylaw, The Council at the expense of the person may carry out remedial action in default and the local governing authority may recover expenses incurred by action in any court of competent jurisdiction or through municipal taxes.
16. The entire sum, or part of, payable by an owner or occupant that remains unpaid by December 31st of the given year in which the sum becomes payable, shall be added to and form part of the taxes.

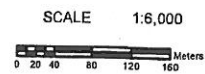

The following rates shall apply for waste management in the Town of Lafleche.

1. Commercial garbage will be charged a monthly fee of Fifteen dollars (\$15.00), and shall be invoiced every two months with the utility billing process. All commercial buildings or properties that generate garbage on site shall be invoiced.
2. Residential garbage will be charged a monthly fee of Ten dollars (\$10.00), and shall be invoiced every two month with the utility billing process. All residential properties that receive blue, curbside recycling bins will be invoiced.
