BYLAW NO. 520-23

A BYLAW GOVERNING THE HOOKUP, USE & RATE FOR RAW WATER

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows.

1. Upon application made at the municipal office, ratepayers will be supplied with raw water to the edge of the property line. This fee, per property, will be Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and must be paid before the service is provided.
2. Commencing on the June 2023 utility billing, the annual raw water rate will be Ninety-Six Dollars (\$96.00) per spigot and will be billed every two months with the utility billing at a rate of Sixteen Dollars (\$16.00) per billing.
3. If any charges remain unpaid as of December 31st of the given year, the amount will be added to the tax roll for that property where the service is provided.
4. All properties that have raw water supply will be charged accordingly.
5. No person shall sell, dispose of or give away, or permit water to be carried or taken away, or use or supply raw water for the use or benefit of others.
6. To control excessive watering and encourage water conservation, the watering will be monitored by Town personnel. The schedule for raw water use is set out in Policy 2-03.
7. In the event that raw water services are abused, the Administrator shall:
 - a) Send a letter to the property owner indicating misuse of the scheduled raw water service and remind them of the schedule;
 - b) If the misuse is continued, there will be a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) fine charged on the next utility billing. (Section 3, applicable);
 - c) If there is still misuse of the raw water service on the said property, Town personnel will shut off the raw water service to the applicable property for one calendar year.
8. Town Council has the right to ration or limit the amount of and use of raw water at any and/or all properties, should the circumstances warrant such action.
9. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw for which no other penalty is provided, shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
10. That Bylaw 497-17 is hereby repealed.
