BYLAW NO. 506-19

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO A FIRE PROTECTION & SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES CONCERNING THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION, SUPPRESSION & EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES**

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Town of Lafleche is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and identified as Exhibit "A" to this Bylaw, with the R.M. of Wood River No. 74 and Thomson Lake Regional Park as named therein.
2. The Mayor and Town Administrator of the Town of Lafleche are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit "A" to this Bylaw.
3. That Bylaw No. 450-10 and 502-18 be repealed upon receiving all signatures in Exhibit "A".



EXHIBIT "A"

**FIRE PROTECTION & SERVICES AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT made in triplicate

BETWEEN:

The *Rural Municipality of Wood River No. 74*, in the Province of Saskatchewan

**And**

The *Town of Lafleche*, in the Province of Saskatchewan

**And**

*Thomson Lake Regional Park*, in the Province of Saskatchewan

(Herein after, all three parties will be referred to as "the municipalities".)

The parties to this Agreement hereby agree as follows:


1. That effective January 1, 2019 all costs pertaining to fire protection services, as defined in Section 2 hereof, shall be shared by the municipalities to this agreement on the following basis:

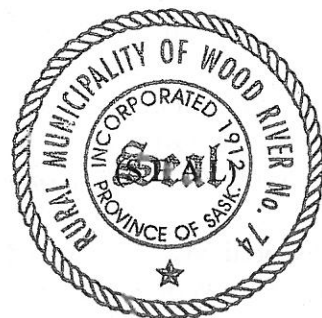
Rural Municipality of Wood River No. 74	- 33.3%
Town of Lafleche	- 33.3%
Thomson Lake Regional Park	- 33.3%
2. The shared costs will include all maintenance and operating costs associated with the equipment, vehicles and building as well as firefighting wages, training and mileage. All fire practices will be paid out a flat fee of \$30 per practice. The fire call out and training wages for fire fighters will be \$20 per hour and for the Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief, \$25 per hour. The mileage rate will be \$0.50 per kilometer.
3. Fire protection services shall be delivered by the Lafleche Wood River Fire Department.
4. Fire fees, relative to the service provided, shall be Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750) for the first hour and Four Hundred and Fifty (\$450) for each subsequent hour. The wages of the fire fighters will be charged according to the time spent responding, as identified in Section 2 of this bylaw.
5. Additional costs incurred by any/all outside forces, agencies, and/or fire departments in prevention, suppression and emergency response services will be in addition to those noted in Section 2 of this bylaw.
6. The Town of Lafleche shall, on behalf of the Lafleche Wood River Fire Department, charge the cost of the fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services as follows:
  - a) To the insuring party in the event that the Lafleche Wood River Fire Department responds to an incident on an road way in any municipality or regional park involving vehicles baring *current and valid* license plates;

- b) To the registered owner, if the said service is provided with the limits of the Town of Lafleche, with the exception of Section 6.a) of this bylaw;
  - c) To the Rural Municipality of Wood River No. 74, if the said service is provided within the boundaries of the municipality, with the exception of Thomson Lake Regional Park, the Town of Lafleche and Section 6.a) of this bylaw;
  - d) To Thomson Lake Regional Park Authority, if the said service is provided within the boundaries of the Park, with the exception of Section 6.a) of this bylaw;
  - e) In the event the Lafleche Wood River Fire Department responds to other municipalities with whom agreements have been signed, fees will be invoiced as per those agreements.
7. If all or any portion of the charges as noted in Section 6 of this bylaw remain unpaid after 60 days or by December 31 of the said year, the municipality shall add the amount owing to the tax roll, or lease, of the said property.
8. This agreement shall come into force and be effective as of January 1, 2019, upon the signing and sealing by all the municipalities.
9. This agreement may be revised or altered by majority consent of the municipalities.


