BYLAW NO. 500-18

A BYLAW TO GOVERN THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN TOWN LIMITS

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. No fireworks are to be set off within the town limits without prior written approval from Town Council;
- 2. Approval may be subject to any conditions Council deems necessary to ensure the safety of all people and property;
- 3. Approval for location of fireworks to be set off will be at Council's discretion, all fireworks shall be set off within the limits of the sportsgrounds and/or baseball diamonds;
- 4. Any person who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) and in default of payment, imprisonment for not less than Thirty (30) days.
- 5. That Bylaw No. 349-98 be repealed.
