

BYLAW NO. 200

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAFLECHE  
WITH RESPECT TO LIVE STOCK AND POULTRY

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:-

1. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the Town.
2. No person shall graze any cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the limits of the Town.
3. No person shall keep any horses, cattle and other live stock, poultry, pigeons, foxes, mink, rabbits, skunks and any animals reared for the bearing of fur, or any of them, within the limits of the Town.
4. Any person who infringes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith shall be liable on summary conviction to the provisions of the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Lafleche.
5. Bylaw Number 189 of 1974 and amending Bylaw Number 190 of 1975 are hereby repealed.
