


ITEMS STORED ON TOWN OWNED PROPERTY

Policy No. 26-13

PURPOSE: To regulate item(s) stored on Town owned property

1. Any person(s) wishing to store item(s) on a town owned property must register the items at the Town Office in order for the Administrator to take to a Council meeting for Approval. Council has the right to refuse any item(s).
2. Upon Council approval the Administrator will record and log the stored items and invoice the person wishing to store the item(s) \$50.00 per month. In the event that Council does not approve the item(s) the person(s) wishing to store the Administrator will inform the person of Councils decision.
3. The Administrator will have any (item(s) not registered with the Town but stored on town property recorded and hauled to the municipal nuisance ground and stored there for a period of 90 days. Items that are claimed within the 90 day period will be subject to a \$30.00 per day storage fee required to be paid to the Town before the items will be returned. If the item(s) are left unclaimed after 90 days the items will be become the property of the Municipality and be disposed of in any manner that the Council directs. Storage fees plus all costs the Town of Lafleche incurs in removing the items from town owned property will be the responsibility of owner of said items.
4. Person(s) who register item(s) with the Town of Lafleche for storage on town owned property but default on two or more monthly payments of \$50.00 will cause their registration to be deemed void. Once the Town of Lafleche has deemed a registration to be void the item(s) under that registration will be dealt with as per section 3 of this policy.
5. Person(s) who have received approval from Council to store items on town owned property will be solely responsible for the maintenance of the said lot(s). Person(s) who fail to keep the lot(s) maintained will cause their registration to be deemed void. Once the Town of Lafleche has deemed a registration to be void the item(s) under that registration will be dealt with as per section 3 of this policy.

**TOWN OF LAFLECHE
POLICY 24-2013
BEING A POLICY TO GOVERN THE CUTTING OF HAY
ON TOWN OWNED PROPERTIES.**

Whereas the Town of Lafleche has approximately 9.5 acres of land within its boundaries, as documented on the map attached to and forming part of this policy, that is conducive to being baled for feed; and

Whereas the Town does not have the equipment to put up the hay nor the need for salvaged hay,

Therefore be it resolved that the town place an ad in town requesting tenders for the salvage of the hay on or before the May 1st in the given year; and further,

That the successful candidate must be willing to enter into an agreement with the Town of Lafleche, as attached to and forming part of this policy, outlining the terms and conditions for the salvaging of hay on town property.

This policy was adopted on the 9th day of May, 2013.
