BYLAW NO. 527-24

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A BASE TAX  
AS PER SECTION 290 OF THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows.

DEFINITIONS

1. In this bylaw:

- (a) "Assessment Identification Number" means the number assigned to each parcel(s) of land in the municipality by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency;
- (b) "Classification" means the property class assigned to each property, pursuant to Section 39 of *The Municipalities Regulations*.

BASE TAX RULES

- 2. A base tax amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$750.00) will be levied against all taxable land, including agricultural, residential and commercial/industrial, where an assessment identification number and classification have been assigned. This includes land with all taxable improvements, including agricultural, residential and commercial/industrial.


That Bylaw 493-17 is hereby repealed.
