
BYLAW NO. 357-99

BEING A BYLAW TO GOVERN ITEMS
STORED ON TOWN OWNED PROPERTY

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. An person(s) wishing to store items on town owned property must register said items at the town office.
2. The Council for the Town of Lafleche has the right to refuse any items.
3. A fee of Ten Dollars per month will be charged per item stored on town owned property. Items stored on town owned property for One day out of a given month will be deemed to be "One Month" for billing purposes and will be subjected to the fee of Ten Dollars.
4. The town will be required to give a minimum of Twenty Four hours written notice when requesting that registered items be removed from Town owned property.
5. All items stored on town owned property that are not registered at the town office will be hauled to the town owned nuisance ground. The town will not be responsible for unregistered items left on town owned property and hauled to the nuisance ground.
6. Persons who register an item with the town for storage on town owned property but default on two or more monthly payments of Ten Dollars will cause their registration to become nil and void. Once the town considers a registration to be nil and void the items under that registration will be dealt with as per Section 5 of this bylaw.
7. A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality. (Bylaw No. 323-95)
