

**TOWN OF LAFLECHE
BYLAW NO. 540-26**

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE WASTE MANAGEMENT BYLAW NO. 538-25.

The Council of the Town of Lafleche, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That provision 8 of the Waste Management Bylaw No. 538-25 is amended from:
 8. Commercial waste collection services are mandatory for all commercial properties in Town. Where waste accumulation is perceived to exceed a cart, the contractor will supply either one additional cart or a bin, upon review with the owner. The fees charged for this service, as provided in Schedule 'B,' will be charged to the owner and included in the Town's bi-monthly utility billing.


TO:

8. Commercial waste collection services through the Town are mandatory for all commercial properties in Town.
 - a. An exception to the mandatory service may be granted at Council's discretion, should a commercial property owner present an agreement for waste collection and disposal to Council which Council deems satisfactory and complete.
 - b. Where an exception has not been made, and where waste accumulation is perceived to exceed a cart, the contractor will supply either one additional cart or a bin, upon review with the owner.
 - c. Where an exception has not been made, the fees charged for this service, as provided in Schedule 'B,' will be charged to the owner and included in the Town's bi-monthly utility billing.
 - d. Where an exception has been made, and where a commercial property changes hands, the exception will be deemed expired, and Town services will be mandatory, until provision 8. a. is deemed to apply.
2. That, following provision 10, additional provisions be added and all subsequent provisions have their numeral amended accordingly:
 11. All households of the Town have a limit, per visit to the transfer station, of a maximum of 10 garbage bags, to a maximum of 30 garbage bags per calendar year (January to December).
 12. That, in the event a household exceeds these limits, a fee of \$20 be payable to the Town per garbage bag.
 13. A tipping fee of \$25 per piece of furniture or mattress be payable to the Town.
 14. Only items permitted in the Town's license will be accepted.
 15. The Nuisance Ground Attendant reserves the right to inspect and refuse any waste.


