Bylaw No. 536-25

2025-266 WEGNER/FEHLER – That Bylaw No. 536-25, being a bylaw to deal with the restraining, regulating, and disposal of cats, dogs and dangerous dogs, be read a third time, adopted, signed and sealed by the Mayor and Administrator. **CARRIED**

2026 Council Indemnity & Remuneration

2025-267 FAUSER/KIRKPATRICK – That the following rates of indemnity and remuneration be set for the 2026 calendar year:

- Council meetings and Committee meetings: \$125 per for Council members, \$150 per for Mayor;
- Convention: \$125 per day for Council members, \$150 per day for Mayor;
- Meal allowance for the Mayor and Council: \$65 per day;
- For the personal vehicle use while conducting municipal business: \$0.56 per km; and
- Hourly rate for committee meetings and office supervision: minimum one hour and up to three hours, \$30 per hour. **CARRIED**

- All elected council members have completed and filed their Public Disclosure Statement with the Administrator as required by legislation. **CARRIED**

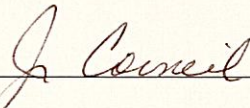

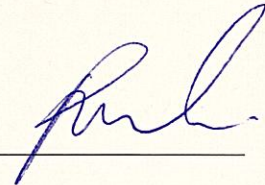
